

### Sanitary harvest (share of annual harvest)




### Technology by harvest volume

## Slovenian State Forests At a Glance



Roughly 58% of Slovenia is covered by forest, which makes Slovenia the third most forested country in Europe. 20% of Slovenia's forests are owned by the state. The Republic of Slovenia founded the company Slovenski državni gozdovi, d. o. o. (SiDG) in 2016, which has been managing state-owned forests ever since.

Our main economic activity is forestry – harvesting trees and selling roundwood, which represents our main source of income. Our main customers are Slovenian wood processing companies and thus we shape a favourable business environment for further development of the Slovenian wood industry.


We also perform silvicultural, forest protection, environmental and forest infrastructure work, by which we invest back into the forests.

Forest management plans are prepared by the Slovenia Forest Service, the public forestry service. They perform public services in all forests (e. g. planning, advising, tree marking ...), regardless of the ownership. All operational forestry activities are the responsibility of forest owners.

Slovenian state forests are well preserved, with high growing stock and with a large proportion of thicker trees. The forests are, almost without exception, regenerated naturally. We have healthy populations of large carnivores (bear, wolf and lynx) and numerous excellently preserved forest habitats.

Every year we organise numerous events to promote forests and active, environmentally friendly leisure in nature.
